Carolyn Rice and Quota International Recognized for Human Rights Work

(Washington, D.C.) Carolyn Rice, International President of Quota International and its charitable arm, the We Share Foundation, was recently honored for her work to advance human rights by the United Nations Association of the National Capital Area. On December 9, 2005, Rice and both organizations were recognized at the Human Rights Day Luncheon, which highlights individuals and organizations that have made special contributions to the advancement of human rights.

Quota International, Inc., is an 86 year-old international service organization that links members of all ages, occupations, and nationalities in a worldwide network of service and friendship. Active in her community for 36 years and a Quotarian for 17, Rice has watched 300 clubs around the world work to serve their communities during her tenure as 2005-2006 International President. Under her leadership, the We Share Foundation's United Nations Association Blue Ribbon award-winning Club-to-Club Service program, which provides resources for service in developing countries, has expanded to include 14 projects serving disadvantaged women and children and deaf

individuals in Fiji, India, Malaysia, Suriname, and the Philippines. She also directs the We Share Foundation's Volunteers in Action program's efforts to provide resources and support to all Quota communities so they can serve their communities effectively.
