***Quotarian* Magazine Receives APEX Award of Excellence**

(Washington, D.C.)— Quota International’s annual membership magazine, the *Quotarian*, has been honored with a Gold Award in the 2007 APEX Awards for Publication Excellence competition—the fifth year the magazine has been recognized in the Print Four-Color Magazine & Journals category. The annual competition, which recognizes excellence in graphic design, editorial content, and overall communications, received nearly 5,000 entries this year, of which about 20 percent received a Gold Award.

The *Quotarian* has been published every year since the inception of Quota International, an 88 year-old international service organization that links members of all ages, occupations, and nationalities in a worldwide network of service and friendship. Its charitable arm, the We Share Foundation, supports members by operating service programs, awarding grants, and offering technical support, education, information, and publications.

Publications like the *Quotarian* provide the information and inspiration to link together members of 300 clubs in 14 countries around the globe. The 2007 award-winning edition included a feature story on the organization’s work with the United Nations and other international non-governmental organizations, updates on club activities and the Club-to-Club program that supports life-saving projects in developing countries, and a centerfold

photograph that won first prize in the We Share Foundation's International Photography competition.
