Within the club Lynne has held the executive positions of President, Vice President, and Secretary many times over. Treasurer was one position that never appealed to Lynne. Lynne has served on all committees at a club level and in August 2016, Lynne received her 25 years of service pin. Lynne has also been the editor of our monthly bulletin that we all look forward to reading at our meetings.

Lynne has taken every opportunity to represent the Condobolin club at many Quota functions where she would meet up with old acquaintances and friends and also to make new friends. This is something that Lynne enjoyed and was never a chore for her to grasp this opportunity with both hands.

Lynne attended the South Pacific Area Meetings every two years, taking her to Canberra, Townsville and Coffs Harbour.
