Georgie Jeffries was a dedicated Quotarian for over fifty years, and passed away recently at age 109 years on September 24, 2016. Her Memorial Service was held on her 110th Birthday. In her Self-Profile, Georgie wrote,

“When we (with husband Jack) bought our business in June 1953, I received an invitation to become a member of the Quota Club of Katoomba, a very prestigious Ladies Classified Service Club with a Major Classification of ‘Retail’ and Minor Classification ‘Sports Goods & Toys’. I was thrilled to become a Quotarian and join in the good work we did in helping Community and Charitable organizations in their efforts for over 50 years. I was initiated and received my sparkling Q Badge in January 1955 and wore it with pride until membership declined from a high of 50 plus to a low of 4 and we, with great sadness, handed in our Charter during which much valuable work had been accomplished”.

Georgie not only served in every office of her Quota Club and twice as District Secretary-Treasurer to two District Governors, but held membership and executive positions in many community organizations in and around Katoomba, too numerous to mention, but all in the support of her husband and daughters’ interests and to help make the community from which she got so much pleasure, a happy, caring community for everyone.
