Margaret (Meg) Rogers passed away at the age of 103, still a financial member of Quota International of Redcliffe and the only remaining Charter Member. Meg joined the Quota Club of Redcliffe as a Charter Member in April 1957 with the Major Classification of 'Retail' and the Minor classification of 'Hardware Builders Supplies'. Meg was a dedicated Quotarian and served as a Director on the Board several times, but was never interested in accepting an Officer Role in the club, preferring to work quietly in the background and give her full support to the service projects which the club was involved with in the early days.

Although Meg had been in a High Care Residence for a number of years and had little physical contact with club activities, right up to her death she was receiving a copy of the Club's Meeting Minutes each month and was interested in what was going on and being achieved.

Meg also gave her time and commitment to a number of other organizations in Redcliffe, particularly the Redcliffe Red Cross Branch of which she was a life-time member.

Meg was a true lady, a very gentle lady, and she will be missed.
